Patrol conducted in the WALTON area between 07:00hrs and 11:00hrs on 10/02/20.

Patrols made on the off road motobike. I was joined by my colleague on the off road bike as part of his normal patrols. School patrols conducted at Walton Junior School. I made arrangements for the council Enforcement Team to attend to blitz the area. 1 X motorist issued with a TOR for using a mobile phone whilst driving. No other issues in relation to parking however we did speak to a lot of local residents in relation to the parking issues. They were happy to see the police and the local council and we were tied up for quite a while discussing the issue with around 10 locals. Plans have been put in action for further patrols of the area.
