Patrols:

PC foster reports,

I have worked Wakefield Safe Scheme overtime today (21/08/2026) between 1600 x 2000 hrs at Walton.

I have achieved the following –

- 1 x TOR – Use Mobile phone
- 1 x TOR – Excess speed 30 MPH (Oakenshaw Lane from the village towards Doncaster Road)
- 1 x TOR – Unsafe load
- 4 x TOR – No Seatbelt
- 2 x TOR – No MOT
- 1 x TOR – Glass not as prescribed

PC Steel reports,

Patrols made on 21/08 between 14:00 X 15:00 on off road bike purely to target Nature Reserve and patrol for nuisance bikes and illegal/nuisance kids fishing or causing ASB (due to increased potential during school holidays)

The area was very quiet. I was stopped by a male riding a push bike through the area who just wanted to talk about speeding vehicles. His information was noted and I explained the area is targetted by specialist traffic officers.

Several dog walkers were spoken to and they're only issue was other dog walkers not securing their dogs when requested. Regarding kids/bikes etc noone had any complaints whatsoever.

PC Halloran reports,

Safe Scheme patrols conducted between and 16:00-18:00hrs 23/08/2026.

I ensured that I completed 1hr static observations on Oakenshaw Lane, stopping any vehicles that appeared to be travelling too fast to take appropriate action where necessary. There were no calls for service in the area whilst I was conducting patrols.

I also made general patrols of the area with nothing of note occurring.

*****Further to previous entries – along with colleagues from the bike team and SAFE scheme officers we have been compiling intell regarding a particular address in Walton and their use of illegal electric motorbikes. Following this intell gathering last week as part of my regular shifts I was able to follow a bike from the address and Walton and detain the bike and rider as it left the village into Crofton. The bike was seized and the rider prosecuted. I will also be liaising with Wakefield housing to impose further actions on the tenants*****

PC 1845 Blore reports

Safe scheme carried out Thursday 20/08 between 10:00 and 12:00

The whole of the parish was patrolled however footfall was very quiet due to the poor weather, few persons around the nature reserve with dogs but doing quick walks and not staying at the locus for any length of time.

Golf course area checked which again was quiet with just a few brave souls playing in the poor weather nothing of note at the hotel or down the track.

The field on Brooklands checked after the last school holiday damage caused with ramps being made, nothing new and all in order.

Rest of parish patrolled without any calls for service or incidents of note.

Pc Steel reports,

Patrols made on off road bike on 18th August between 15:00 X 17:00.

Due to school holidays I concentrated on areas where youths are likely to gather and potentially cause no issues. Local parks were both fine (and parking was all in order). Both been used by groups of kids, some on their own and some with adults. I spoke to a group of youths on pushbikes heading down to the woods near the golf course. All very polite and engaged with me well. Absolutely no issues.

I then spent some time around the colliery and onto Oakenshaw via the tracks ensuring the fishing ponds were checked. Again all in order. The colliery was actually very quiet with only a few cars.

The parade of shops and surrounding shops patrolled has this has been the only area in Walton recently where nuisance bikes have been sighted. No issues today and from speaking to a couple of local residents there doesn't seem to have been an issue recently. I have been through our bike logs and there have been no calls for service.
