Patrols:

PC 599 THIMM Reports

Village patrolled on Tuesday 3rd February between 1600 x 2000 hrs in unmarked Police vehicle.

Potential ASB hotspots covered and all found to be in order.

Presence around Oakenshaw Lane re speeding vehicles in new 30mph area. Vehicles checked on PNC and all found to be in order.

No live logs whilst in the village. No issues to report

PC Steel reports,

Patrols made in a marked police van on 05/02 between 12:00 X 14:00. As requested the patrols were mainly split between patrolling Oakenshaw Lane, and Shay Lane due to speeding motorists. The weather today was dreadful (heavy rain) so this seemed to have a calming effect on the speed motorists were going. No problems at all.

I also patrolled the area near the hairdresser and cafe on school lane with reference to bad parking. No issues today at all.

The usually busy areas (nature reserve) were completely empty as expected due to the weather. All in all a very quiet shift with no issues at all.

PC 1845 Blore reports

Safe scheme patrol carried out on Tuesday 10/02/2026 between 11:00 x 13:00

Speed checks carried out as requested entering the village on shay lane and Oakenshaw lane roads relatively quiet at the times of the speed checks all vehicles checked within the regulation speed limits. No drivers required action taking or words of advice bit as stated road quiet.

Nature reserve patrolled. Car park fairly busy with a number of walkers using the site, nothing reported to officer or highlighted while in the carpark.

Rest of the parish was patrolled including Waterton Hall golf course and hotel. The course has an automatic electric gate up and running now which helps with the security of the site and limits access to the car park.

Nothing of note reported or calls for service during the patrolled hours

PC Steel reports,

Patrols made on 11/02 on Off Road Motorbike between 13:00 X 14:00.

The time was spent concentrating on Oakenshaw Lane targeting any speeding motorists. I also spent some time along the footpath at the side of the train station leading onto Oakenshaw. No issues, although as per several recent patrols the weather was dreadful due to heavy rain, so this will no doubt help the speeding issue due to drivers naturally slowing down.

PC Steel reports

Patrols made on 12/02 between 13:00 X 14:00 hrs. As per previous patrols my time was spent moving up and down Oakenshaw Lane to monitor traffic along the new 30 MPH.

The only issue was a driver whose car broke down right at the end of Oakenshaw Lane causing a lot of issues. I assisted her in moving her vehicle and offering the driver some assistance as they were starting to get a bit panicked. Vehicle removed by recovery truck a short while later.

PC Foster reports,

I have worked Wakefield Safe Scheme today (Thursday, 12 February 2026) on a 1100 x 1500 hrs shift paying attention to Walton and Crofton.

Whilst in Walton I paid attention to vehicles entering the village from Oakenshaw Lane.

It was noticeable whilst showing a presence and conducting checks on Oakenshaw Lane by the stables that people appear to be taking notice of the new 30 MPH limit as traffic was slower than in the past.

As requested I conducted checks close to the wildlife park on Shay Lane. In general the speeds were within the 30 MPH limit.

Mobile patrol was carried out in an marked RPU vehicle.
